0 to 11	Laughs & gurgles			
	Uses voice, gesture, eye contact to keep peoples attention			
8 to 20	Enjoys finding own nose as part of a naming game			
	Learns that own voice & actions have an affect on others			
	Uses pointing with eye gaze to make requests & share interest			
	Engages other person to help achieve a goal			
16 to 26	Explores new toys & environments but checks in with familiar adult			
	Gradually able to engage in pretend play with toys			
	Demonstrates sense of self as an individual eg wants to do things independently			
22 to 30	Seperates from main carer with support and encouragment			
	Expresses own preferences & interests			
30 to 50	Can select & use activities & resources with help			
	Welcomes & values praise for what they have done			
	Enjoys responsibility of carrying out small tasks			
	Is more outgoing towards unfamiliar people & more confident in new situations			
	Confident to talk to other children when playing & will communicate freely about own home			
	Shows confidence in asking others for help			
40 to 60	Confident to speak to others about own wants, interests & opinions			
	Can describe self in positive terms & talk about abilities			
ELG	Children are confident to try new activities and say why they like some more than others			
	They are confident to speak in a familiar group, will talk about their ideas and will choose the resources they need for their activities
